

OGT “Offener Ganztag” (open entire day)

The OGT offers caring possibilities from 7 am until 4 pm on school days.

Subsequent the teaching, students can partake in homework care, play care and leisure courses after enrolment.

Bicycle exam

whilst attending grade 4, the students will partake a bicycle exam. The police supports and holds both, theoretic and practical exams.

As the students are allowed to come to school by bike on their own, beginning grade 3, we ask you to study and train the route. Lead attention to possible dangers and risks. Ensure that the bike is street safe and your child is wearing a proper fitting helmet.

Daily reading section

In order to further the students reading skills, a daily reading section as been instated in the Bürgerschule beginning with the school year 24/25.

Swimming lessons

Throughout the public pools operating times grade levels 3 and 4 will be instructed in swimming.

Swimming lessons are part of the regular physical education teachings and are therefore compulsory.

School social work

Our schools social workers are supporting as problems and conflicts occur. Preventive measures as well as behaviour and social training could be offered to small groups. Contact details can be found on our home page.

School events

Our school year is packed with a variety of school events, e.g. running day, sports day, ball game day, Vogelschießen (picking of birds), visits to cinema, theatre, library, art exhibition, christmas play, reading day, carnival. Further informations will be provided by the schools head office or the home group teacher.

Once a year, since 1845, a traditional Vogelschießen with picking of the bird, procession through town and dance is celebrated. It is always held on a Friday and Saturday, often mid June, which is a compulsory school event for each student on both days. Parents representatives

Every home group is voting their parents representatives at their first parents meeting in 1st and 3rd grade level. These are the contact people and will work in alliance with the home group teacher. These will also be the ones inviting for the parents meetings.

The **Schulelternbeirat** (committee of parents representatives) are meetings of all parents representatives, in which important issues of school life are discussed and voted on. The head of this committee (usually three representatives) meet monthly with the principal. Current topics are discussed and debated on in those meetings.

Breakfast

A breakfast time is scheduled daily (8.55 am – 9.05 am) in the home group.

The club "Glückstarter" offers breakfast items on a regular basis at the kiosk. As parents, please care for a healthy and balanced meal and drink for your own child.

Remedial teaching / challenging teaching

The colleagues from the remedial teaching facility support the school mainly within the areas of preventive work and inclusion.

Compulsory remedial teaching lessons and voluntary challenging lessons are offered throughout all grade levels. Parents will receive further information through the home group teacher if necessary.

Class trip and excursions

Within the framework of schooling class excursions will take place throughout the school year. During grade 3 or 4 the students will participate on a class trip, which lasts several days.

Kulturfonds

The oldest child of each family pays 15€, the second 8€. Every further child is exempt from this. The money goes towards school events, theatre visits or excursions, which will be partly or fully financed.

Sick note

In the case of your child being sick, it has to be reported/ excused the same day until 7.45 am, either by phone call, by email in the schools office or via the school's homepage. If the child's absence continues for several days, a doctors note should be provided. Important: In case of a contagious sickness, the child is first allowed back to school as the child is no longer contagious itself.

Sick or injured children

As needed, parents or a child's relations will be contacted via phone call and asked to collect such child. Please make sure to be accessible throughout the school day.

Important: Changes of phone numbers shall be given immediately to the school office, for us to be able to contact you if required.

Lunch at the mensa

Monday through Friday the children can eat lunch in the school's mensa after their lessons. Bookings and payments are concluded online exclusive. Two different options are offered every school day. (Registration and bookings via homepage)
